



Cardamine heleniae

Common Name(s):

Cress

Current Threat Status (2018):

Data Deficient

Distribution:

Scattered records, mostly in disturbed sites. Its small size means it is probably under-recorded to date.

Habitat:

Disturbed sites - garden pots, earth paths.

Features:

Prolific seeder and establishes freely; it has considerable weed potential
