



Rytidosperma setifolium

Common Name(s):

Bristle tussock, mountain danthonia

Current Threat Status (2012):

Not Threatened

Distribution:

Endemic. North Island from Te Moehau, Mt Pirongia and the Raukumara Range south. South Island throughout

Habitat:

Montane to alpine mainly in grassland, herb and fell-field, but also on rocky bluffs, especially in the northern part of its range.

Not Threatened
