



## *Berggrenia cyclospora*

### **Common Name(s):**

None

### **Distribution:**

Auckland, New Zealand

### **Features:**

Ascomata are flesh-coloured, sessile, lobed, up to 2 cm tall. The asci are cylindrical, and 8-spored. The ascospores are globose, hyaline, and 18 µm diameter. *Berggrenia aurantiaca*, also described from New Zealand, has elliptical ascospores, which are 22–25 x 16–18 µm.
