Features:

The basidiocarps are adherent, broadly effused, membranous to ceraceous, smooth, up to 1 mm thick. The fertile area is greyish orange, not changing colour in KOH. The margin is abrupt and not differentiated. The subiculum is pale yellow. The basidia are cylindrical, $40-50 \times 5-6 \mu m$, thin walled, and hyaline, with 4 sterigmata up to $3.5 \mu m$ long. The basidiospores are ellipsoid to narrowly ellipsoid, $5-5.5 \times 2.5-3 \mu m$, hyaline, smooth, thin walled.

Fruiting:

Known only from the type collected in 1914.
