

Cotoneaster perpusillus

Common Name(s):

Rockspray cotoneaster

Distribution:

Casual, with a few scattered records from probably abandoned garden sites.

Habitat:

Needs very good drainage; drought resistant once established.

Fruiting:

Can be prolific; scarlet
