



Abutilon indicum

Common Name(s):

Indian abutilon, Indian mallow

Distribution:

Occasionally grown in NZ gardens; first seedlings seen near planted shrubs in 2017 near Whanganui

Habitat:

Seedlings appear near planted specimens

Fruiting:

A dry ridged capsule
