

SOME INDIGENOUS VASCULAR PLANTS ON LAND OWNED BY WILLIAM AND SHARON TERVIT, 48 ASHTON FITCHETT DRIVE, BROOKLYN, WELLINGTON, THE ROUTE FOLLOWED WAS:

- (1) DOWN THE VALLEY OF THE STREAM WHICH FORMS THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE LAND UNDER NEGOTIATION WITH WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL, TO THE FORKS AT NZMS 260 SHEET R27 PT Q27 WELLINGTON, G.R. 549881, THEN
- (2) ALONG THE NORTH-FLOWING STRETCH OF STREAM, FOR APPROXIMATELY 300 METRES, TO THE FORKS AT G.R. 548883, THEN
- (3) UP THE WEST-SOUTHWEST-FLOWING TRIBUTARY FOR 250 METRES, THEN
- (4) EASTWARDS UP TO THE ROAD NORTH OF THE PARADE GROUND.
