Site description:

This 21.9 hectare covenant owned by Charles Skeet, consists of a steep dry hillslope covered in original bush (pers. comm. D. McLaren) with several runoff gullies. The only permanent water is a branch of the Tawhiriwaimanuka Stream, which bounds the covenant for the lower part of the eastern boundary and contributes to the ponds found at the bottom end of the covenant.

There are some very large trees in this bush patch, Totara (Podocarpus totara) Kahikatea (Dacrydium dacrydioides) Black Maire (Nestegis cunninghamii and Matai (Prumnopitys taxifolia) and a subcanopy of Titoki (Alectryon excelsus). This type of bush is mainly on the flatter lower slopes and grades up into tall Kanuka (Kunzea ericoides) further up. There are also some large Kowhai (Sophora microphylla) and Ngaio (Myoporum laetum) in one of the gullies.

The forest floor has a sparse covering except in the light wells where patches of native grasses and Corybas trilobus grow. Stream banks have their own collection of species including a variety of Pellaea rotundifolia with pinnae approaching P. falcata in size and shape. A Pterostylis species (possibly P. porecta Ian St George pers.comm.) grows in one of the runoff gullies and would extend the known range of this species.

The ridge slopes have a very interesting assemblage of species with the dominant being tall Kanuka (Kunzea ericoides) but with species "bands" as you progress upslope. Initially regenerating and smaller maire with Coprosma rubra and Coprosma linariifolia. The ground is almost carpeted in places by Clematis paniculata which is just spreading over. the ground. Here too is the best population of Wind grass (Anemanthele lessoniana) and Corybas trilobus is everywhere. Tarata (Pittosporum eugenioides) is quite common through here as well. Further up Fivefinger (Pseudopanax arboreus) makes an appearance in a rather narrow altitudinal band. Small patches of less common species in the area occur here with Rasp fern (Doodia media) and Helichrysum aggregatum and Wahlenbergia rupestris and W. violacea.

Two small patches of Teucridium parviflorum were found near one of the ponds at the foot of the covenant.

The covenant was protected by shelterbelts and although a lot of the shelter trees remain there has been some logging for timber and consequent exposure to the wind on the top and the western side. This has allowed considerable damage to some of the bigger trees and major infestation with exotic grasses and weeds

The main weed problem in the bush is black wattle with one large old tree with a fair amount of seeding around but could be cleaned up without too much effort. Carex divulsa is found at the bottom of the hill and could pose a problem later on if it spreads. One plant of Pomaderris aspera was seen and it may pay to get rid of it. Around the pond at the bottom of the covenant there are a number of troublesome weed. Honeysuckle (Lonicera sp.) and Ivy (Hedrix sp.) need to be treated.

With the large amount of Maire in the bush, possum control could see Tupeia antarctica return. No sign of this mistletoe at the moment but it's presence in the nearby covenant at Ahi Paku means it is in the immediate area. The scarcity of Fuchsia (1 tree) may be down to these animals as well.

The survey of this very interesting piece of original bush would be classed as medium with 11 hours having been spent botanising it.
