## Site description:

The area surveyed consists of a large area of mainly flax swamp with a steep bank on the north side with some native bush and is drained by a watercourse below this bank. The small stream which enters the swamp at the eastern end has been dammed to form a small pond. The watercourses then run either side of the swamp passing through a culvert where the road bounds the area to the west. Most of the swamp is in flax but there is an area just down from the pond where some kahikatea (*Dacrydium dacrydioides*), and scrub occupy a less wet area. This area contains manuka (*Leptospermum scoparium*), *Olearia virgata*, small kohuhu (*Pittosporum tenuifolium*) and cabbage trees (*Cordyline australis*) along with a lot of *Carex secta* and *Carex virgata*. Of note was the occurrence of the small mistletoe *Korthosella salicornioides* on some of the manuka and also the presence of the large swamp astelia (*Astelia grandis*).

On the true left of the small stream is a bush patch which appears to be a remnant of what must have been the original land cover on the low hills in this area. This area and the part of the swamp surveyed are grazed by cattle which have severely depleted the bush areas but have also kept down the growth of rank grass in the swamp & shrub area.

There is a significant list of adventive species with barberry (*Berberis glaucocarpus*) and old mans beard (*Clematis vitalba*) being the main concerns, occurring along the bank to the north of the swamp area
