This list is a compilation of species listed by TCPL investigation report (Graeme Taylor, compiler of botanical information 1989), and by earlier authors on various islands. Species names have been updated where it is reasonably certain what name is appropriate; authors have been cited against doubtful records. Records by Colin Ogle and staff of DOC since 1987, and B Hartley (1996, pers. comms.) have been added to this list.

<sup>12</sup> Earlier authors recorded *Agropyron scabrum* and/or *Elymus rectisetus*. *E. solandri* (recognised as a valid indigenous species in 1994) was collected for CHR from Moturoa on 20/2/02, and the earlier records from the Sugar Loaf Islands are now all regarded as being this species. The status of *E. multiflorus* on Moturoa is uncertain, because *E. solandri* had not been recorded there before 2002; *E. multiflorus* might be an error?
